It is designed for seafood technologists and quality assurance personnel to develop expertise in the sensory evaluation of shrimp.

Participants will learn to

conduct, interpret and report sensory analyses as a key regulatory tool for ensuring consumer safety and export compliance.

A total of 11 participants

from various seafood export units across India are attending the training, benefiting from expert guidance and practical learning experiences.
